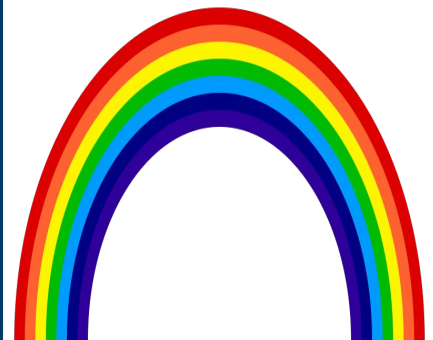

This year's theme is "Igniting Hope", with five sub-themes:

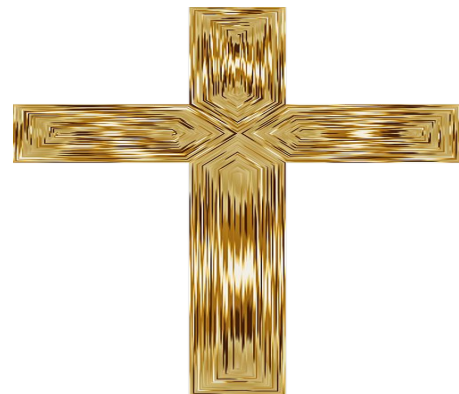
Monday: Our Hope in Christ
